Turn your clocks ahead 1 hour March 8th

1 Peter 2:9 - But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light.

As we look forward to this month of March we will be engaging the Epistle of 1 Peter. This letter is full of encouragement for the believer that endures sufferings. But it also holds the reminder that salvation sets us apart from the world we once inhabited. We are a chosen people -and we've been chosen to proclaim God's goodness.
